NOTICE

A ratification vote on the proposed agreement amendment between the Commonwealth and MOSES is scheduled for **Thursday, February 11, 2010** between the hours of **10:00 AM and 4:30 PM**. All state employees in titles represented by MOSES are entitled to vote and are encouraged to vote, whether or not they are members of MOSES. This Agreement Amendment contains a provision for an Agency Service Fee, which can be equal to but not exceed MOSES dues. MOSES dues are presently \$8.50 per week. MOSES most recent Financial Report in the form of a balance sheet and operating statement listing all receipts and disbursements of the previous fiscal year is available for inspection at the MOSES office, 90 North Washington Street-3rd Floor, Boston, MA, Monday through Friday between the hours of 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM.

Bring the enclosed ballot with you to one of the above voting locations. You may vote a “challenge ballot” if you did not receive a ballot, **or** if you do not bring the ballot **or** if you do not bring positive identification (license or other identification with a picture) **or** if your name is not found on a list of employees represented by MOSES. **Note: If there are newly hired employees or others at your work location who did not receive this information in the mail, please share it with them and inform them that everyone in Unit 9 is allowed to vote on this amendment ratification.**

A summary of proposed changes is included herein as well as more detailed information on the proposed changes to the collective bargaining agreement amendment. Copies of the entire existing collective bargaining agreement including proposed changes will be available at each voting location. The ballots will be counted at each voting location immediately after the polls close and any employee may watch the tabulation and counting procedure.

Please be informed that the Office of Employee Relations has approved up to two (2) hours paid release time for those who have to travel to vote.
